ORDER GRANTING MOTION
TO STAY SUSPENSION OF LICENSE

The Office of the Attorney General of Texas, Petitioner, filed a Motion to Stay Order Suspending License on October 31, 2011, in the above styled case. Respondent, **RICHARD RAMIREZ**, has paid all delinquent child support, has established a satisfactory payment record, or good cause otherwise exists to stay the Decision and Order, issued August 16, 2010, suspending Respondent's driver's license, number 00140682, issued by the Texas Department of Public Safety and nurse's license, number 00070332, issued by the Board of Nursing. The Administrative Law Judge concludes the motion should be granted.

It is therefore, **ORDERED** that the Motion to Stay Order Suspending License is **GRANTED**, and the order suspending Respondent's license(s) is hereby **STAYED**. This stay shall remain subject to a motion to revoke for noncompliance in accordance with TEX. FAM. CODE ANN. § 232.012. This order shall be promptly delivered to the licensing agency for observance. Upon payment of any fee required by the licensing agency under TEX. FAM. CODE ANN. §232.014, the agency will issue the affected license to **RICHARD RAMIREZ** if he is otherwise qualified for the license.
