ORDER OF THE BOARD

During open meeting held in Austin, Texas, on Tuesday, May 10, 2011, the Eligibility and Disciplinary Committee (hereinafter "Committee") heard the above-styled case, based on the failure of the Respondent to appear as required by 22 TEX. ADMIN. CODE Ch. 213.

The Committee of the Texas Board of Nursing finds that notice of the facts or conduct alleged to warrant disciplinary action has been provided to Respondent in accordance with Texas Government Code § 2001.054(c) and Respondent has been given an opportunity to show compliance with all the requirements of the Nursing Practice Act, Chapter 301 of the Texas Occupations Code, for retention of Respondent's license to practice professional nursing in the State of Texas.

The Committee finds that the Formal Charges were properly initiated and filed in accordance with section 301.458, Texas Occupations Code.

The Committee finds that after proper and timely Notice regarding the violations alleged in the Formal Charges was given to Respondent in this matter, Respondent has failed to appear in accordance with 22 TEX. ADMIN. CODE Ch. 213.

The Committee finds that the Board is authorized to enter a default order pursuant to Texas Government Code § 2001.056.

The Eligibility and Disciplinary Committee, after review and due consideration, adopts the proposed findings of fact and conclusions of law as stated in the Formal Charges which are attached hereto and incorporated by reference for all purposes and the Staff's recommended sanction of revocation by default. This Order will be properly served on all parties and all parties will be given an opportunity to file a motion for rehearing [22 TEX. ADMIN.CODE § 213.16(j)]. All parties have a right to judicial review of this Order.

All proposed findings of fact and conclusions of law filed by any party not specifically adopted herein are hereby denied.

NOW, THEREFORE, IT IS ORDERED that Permanent Certificate Number 625502, previously issued to ROBERT BROWN, to practice professional nursing in the State of Texas be, and the same is hereby, REVOKED.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that this Order SHALL be applicable to Respondent's nurse licensure compact privileges, if any, to practice professional nursing in the State of Texas.

FORMAL CHARGES

This is a disciplinary proceeding under Section 301.452(b), Texas Occupations Code. Respondent, ROBERT BROWN, is a Registered Nurse holding license number 625502, which is in Delinquent status at the time of this pleading.

Written notice of the facts and conduct alleged to warrant adverse licensure action was sent to Respondent at Respondent's address of record and Respondent was given opportunity to show compliance with all requirements of the law for retention of the license prior to commencement of this proceeding.

CHARGE I.

On or about October 19, 2010, Respondent's license to practice professional nursing in the State of Louisiana was issued a Summary Suspension - Agreement, by the Louisiana State Board of Nursing, Baton Rouge, Louisiana.

A copy of the Summary Suspension - Agreement, dated October 19, 2010, is attached and incorporated, by reference, as part of this pleading.

The above action constitutes grounds for disciplinary action in accordance with Section 301.452(b)(8), Texas Occupations Code.

CHARGE II.

On or about December 15, 2010, Respondent's license to practice professional nursing in the State of Louisiana was issued a Consent Order, by the Louisiana State Board of Nursing, Baton Rouge, Louisiana.

A copy of the Consent Order, dated December 15, 2010, is attached and incorporated, by reference, as part of this pleading.

The above action constitutes grounds for disciplinary action in accordance with Section 301.452(b)(8), Texas Occupations Code.

NOTICE IS GIVEN that staff will present evidence in support of the recommended disposition of up to revocation of Respondent's license to practice nursing in the State of Texas pursuant to the Nursing Practice Act, Chapter 301, Texas Occupations Code and the Board's rules, 22 Tex. Admin. Code §§ 213.27 - 213.33. Additionally, staff will seek to impose on Respondent the administrative costs of the proceeding pursuant to Section 301.461, Texas Occupations Code. The cost of proceedings shall include, but is not limited to, the cost paid by the Board to the State Office of Administrative Hearings and the Office of the Attorney General or other Board counsel for legal and investigative services, the cost of a court reporter and witnesses, reproduction of records, Board staff time, travel, and expenses. These shall be in an amount of at least one thousand two hundred dollars (\$1,200.00).

NOTICE IS GIVEN that all statutes and rules cited in these Charges are incorporated as part of this pleading and can be found at the Board's website, www.bon.state.tx.us.






TERMS AGREED TO BY LICENSEE

I, ROBERT RAY BROWN, (Respondent), voluntarily agree to sign and have witnessed terms of agreement for the purpose of avoiding formal administrative proceedings with the Louisiana State Board of Nursing.

I, ROBERT RAY BROWN, do say that I freely, knowingly and voluntarily enter into this agreement. I understand that I have a right to a hearing in this matter and I freely waive such right. I understand that I have a right to legal counsel prior to entering into this agreement.

I acknowledge that the Louisiana State Board of Nursing makes the following FINDINGS OF FACT:

1. On January 31, 1997, Respondent was licensed by endorsement as an RN in Louisiana.
2. On July 23, 2002, Respondent was licensed by examination as an APRN in Louisiana.
3. On October 18, 2002, Respondent's collaborative practice agreement to practice with Clifton Salmon and John Smith at Family Medical Clinic in Homer, LA was approved for Legend Drugs only.
4. On September 18, 2003, Respondent was approved to add controlled substances schedules III-V and II for ADD to his collaboration at Family Medical Clinic.
5. On April 26, 2005, Respondent's collaborative practice agreement to practice with Gerald Stell, Michael Chanler, Don Ferguson, Benjamin Leggio, Joseph Bolger, Mark Cimino, William Dennis, Jr., Kelly Filand, Dirk Rainwater, and Faisal Thaljech at Minden Medical Clinic in Minden, LA was approved for legend Drugs only.
6. On July 03, 2007, Respondent was approved to add controlled substances schedules III-V and II for ADD to his practice at Minden Medical Center. Respondent also removed Don Ferguson, Benjamin Leggio, Joseph Bolger, William Dennis, Jr., Kelly Filand, Dirk Rainwater, and Faisal Thaljech from his collaboration at Minden Medical Center.
7. On August 13, 2007, Respondent's collaborative practice agreement approved to add Dcardrc Chao, Abdul Khan, Sevetri Moore, Carter Quayle, Carol Twyman, Frederick Floyd III, Jason Mizell, Harold Paden, Jr., Magdy Shehata, and Mark West to his collaboration at Minden Medical Clinic.
8. On September 17, 2007, Respondent's collaborative practice agreement to practice with Mark Cimino at Family Medicine Associates in Minden, LA was approved.
9. On February 22, 2008, Respondent's collaborative practice agreement to practice with Gerald Stell at Family Medicine Associates was approved. He is also approved with Dr. Stell at Meadowview Health and Rehab in Minden, LA, Town and County Health and Rehab in Minden, LA, and Leslie Lakes Retirement Center in Arcadia, LA.
10. On July 28, 2008, Respondent's collaborative practice agreement to practice with Carlos Brown, Jr. and Paul Hable at Minden Medical Clinic was approved.
11. On August 12, 2008, an anonymous complaint was received alleging that Respondent is prescribing "Adipex" for weight loss. The complaint alleges that Respondent has a "book of signed scripts that he uses."
12. On August 12, 2008, a complaint signed by "Jane Doe, RNP" is received alleging that Respondent is providing substandard care at Minden Medical Clinic. Jane Doe claimed that Respondent wishes to be considered a doctor.



13. On August 22, 2008, an anonymous complaint was received alleging that Respondent gave patient GT narcotics even though she was in treatment for drug abuse and had been diagnosed for bipolar disorder. Complaint alleged that patient overdosed. Stated that she believes Respondent wishes to be a doctor and he believes the rules don't apply to him.
14. On September 05, 2008, a complaint was received signed by Margaree Bynog which alleged that her father, NS, is a drug seeker who goes to Respondent because he supplies him with drugs. The complainant also alleges she told Respondent that NS could not have narcotics but he supplied them anyway. She further alleges Respondent represents himself as a doctor.
15. On December 01, 2008, a demand letter was sent to Respondent regarding allegations made by "Margaree Bynog."
16. On December 09, 2010, a response to demand letter was received from Respondent. Included were a statement related to treatment of NS, as well as signed and notarized statements from NS and TB (NS's daughter) who state that neither of them lodged the complaint, that Respondent's treatment was fine, and that NS has no history of drug abuse. Statement from Respondent alleges that treatment of NS was due to fracturing multiple vertebrae. It is also noted that NS does not have a daughter named Margaree Bynog.
17. On January 05, 2009, an End Investigation Letter was sent to Respondent.
18. On January 07, 2009, an anonymous complaint was received alleging that Respondent is practicing without a medical director at Family Medicine Associates in Minden, LA. Witnesses are purported to be Donna Carter - Minden Medical Clinic DON, Margaret Morciand - Adm. Ast., and Dr. Max Stell. An accompanying statement alleged that Respondent is practicing without collaboration with Dr. Max Stell.
19. On January 08, 2009, a letter was faxed to L.SBN by Gerald Stell. The letter, dated December 22, 2008, states that he will no longer be practicing with Respondent.
20. On January 22, 2009, Respondent's collaborative practice agreement to practice with John Smith at Family Medicine Associates was approved.
21. On March 31, 2009, Respondent's collaborative practice agreement to practice with Monta Patison, Sean Denham, and Elizabeth Anderson-Doze at Minden Medical Center was approved.
22. On June 02, 2009, Respondent's collaborative practice agreement to practice with Charles Baxter, Judy Csatho, Asuquo Esuabana, James Kemmerly, Clayton Overton III, and Menoni Ize-iyamu at Minden Medical Center was approved.
23. On July 31, 2009, Respondent's collaborative practice agreement to practice with Martha Wafor at Minden Medical Center was approved.
24. On September 15, 2009, Respondent's collaborative practice agreement to practice with Elizabeth Anderson-Doze at Family Medicine Associates was approved.
25. On October 08, 2009, Respondent's collaborative practice agreement to practice with David Nelson at Minden Medical Clinic was approved.
26. On November 19, 2009, Respondent's collaborative practice agreement to practice with Iram Zando and Daniel Umoh at Minden Medical Center is approved.



27. On December 16, 2009, Respondent's collaborative practice agreement to practice with Martha Wafer was approved. NOTE: As Respondent already had a CPA with Wafer at Minden Medical Center, it is assumed this is to add Wafer at Family Medicine Associates.
28. On December 29, 2009, a complaint was forwarded by the Louisiana State Board of Medical Examiners. Complaint forwarded from LSBME. The complaint was signed by "Lisa Fontenot" and alleged Respondent was treated her daughter, CE. Complainant alleged CE is a pill seeker, that Complainant informed Respondent of this, and that Respondent continued to prescribe CF, narcotics. Representatives of the Board were unable to reach Complainant after multiple attempts.
29. On January 06, 2010, a demand letter was sent to Respondent regarding allegations surrounding CE and a subpoena duces tecum was sent to Minden Medical Center for CE's medical records.
30. On January 12, 2010, a response to demand letter received from Respondent. Included was a detail of the history, cause for treatment, and treatment plan for CE.
31. On January 25, 2010, medical records of CE were received from Respondent.
32. On January 28, 2010, an anonymous complaint was received alleging that Respondent over prescribes narcotics. Accompanying letter mentioned a 42 year old white male who received large prescriptions of Lorab, Soma, and Xanax.
33. On March 01, 2010, Respondent's collaborative practice agreement to practice with Andrea Lewis-Echols and Dirk Rainwater at Minden Medical Center was approved.
34. On May 20, 2010, an anonymous complaint was received via email. Complainant stated that she is an FNP in Minden and her clinic sees multiple patients who are Respondent's. She says these patients she sees are often drug seekers. She mentioned a patient that was getting Xanax 90/mo, Soma 90/mo, and Lorab 60/mo. She also stated that patients she's seen are prescribed Adipex and have admitted it was prescribed by Respondent, though under another physician's name. Anonymous complaint received via fax which alleged the same information.
35. On July 15, 2010, the Board issued a subpoena duces tecum requesting sixty-three (63) medical records which was hand delivered to Family Medicine Associates of Minden, LLC, 1111 Homer Rd., Minden, LA 71055. A second subpoena duces tecum requesting sixty-three (63) medical records and all records of patients seen for drug overdose from January 2008 until July 15, 2008, was hand delivered to Minden Medical Center, 1 Medical Plaza Place, Minden, LA 71055. Eighty-three (83) records were received in the Board office on July 16, 2010, and were subsequently reviewed. - On August 12, 2008, an anonymous complaint was received alleging that Respondent is prescribing "Adipex" for weight loss. The complaint alleges that Respondent has a "book of signed scripts that he uses."
- On August 12, 2008, a complaint signed by "Jane Doe, RN" is received alleging that Respondent and Regina Willis, NP are providing substandard care at Minden Medical Clinic. Jane Doe claimed that both NPs wish to be considered doctors.

- 03/24/10 – Rx for Amphetamine Salts 10mg #30. Notation on chart section "Chief Complaint" states "Also going to sleep @ the wheel of his truck in AM's; finds himself crossing the line". No evidence of any tests, basis for diagnosis of narcolepsy, or referrals to specialist to confirm diagnosis.

Grounds for disciplinary proceedings against a Registered Nurse are specified in La. R.S. 37:921. Likewise, La. R.S. 37:921 authorizes the Board to probate, limit, restrict or revoke any license issued to Respondent on the grounds that Respondent violated the following provisions of the Nurse Practice Act and the Rules and Regulations promulgated thereof in the following respects:

- Respondent failed to practice nursing in accordance with the legal standards of nursing practice; L.A.C. 46:XLVII.3405.A.a;
- Respondent has violated a rule adopted by the board, an order of the board, or a state or federal law relating to the practice of professional nursing, or a state or federal narcotics or controlled substance law; L.A.C. 46:XLVII.3405.A.p;
- Respondent demonstrated inappropriate, incomplete or improper documentation; L.A.C. 46:XLVII.3405.A.q;

Pursuant to the Louisiana Administrative Procedures Act, R.S. 49:961.C:

If the agency finds that public health, safety, or welfare imperatively requires emergency action, and incorporates a finding to that effect in its order, summary suspension of a license may be ordered pending proceedings for revocation or other action. These proceedings shall be promptly instituted and determined.

Therefore, your Prescriptive Authority to prescribe controlled substances is summarily suspended and you are hereby directed to IMMEDIATELY CEASE AND DESIST IN THE PRACTICE OF PRESCRIBING ANY CONTROLLED SUBSTANCES FOR ANY REASON.


