On this day, the Texas Board of Nursing, hereinafter referred to as the Bo accepted the voluntary surrender of Registered Nurse License Number 689345, issued to RACHEL MARIE GOSLIN, hereinafter referred to as Respondent. This action was taken in accordance with Section 301.453(c) of the Texas Occupations Code.

Respondent waived representation by counsel, informal proceedings, notice and hearing, and agreed to the entry of this Order.

The Board makes the following Findings of Fact and Conclusions of Law.

FINDINGS OF FACT

1. Prior to the institution of Agency proceedings, notice of the matters specified below in these Findings of Fact was provided to Respondent and Respondent was given an opportunity to show compliance with all requirements of the law for retention of the license.
2. Respondent waived representation by counsel, informal proceedings, notice and hearing, and agreed to the entry of this Order.
3. Respondent holds a license to practice professional nursing in the State of Texas, which is in Delinquent status.
4. Respondent received an Associate Degree in Nursing from Victoria College, Victoria, Texas, on May 10, 2002. Respondent was licensed to practice professional nursing in the State of Texas on August 6, 2002.
5. Respondent's professional nursing employment history is unknown.

6. On or about February 24, 2008, Respondent obtained twenty (20) tablets of Lortab from the Target Pharmacy, Houston, Texas, under her own name, through the use of an unauthorized telephonically communicated prescription. Respondent's conduct was likely to deceive the pharmacy and possession of Lortab through use of an unauthorized telephonically communicated prescription is prohibited by Chapter 481 of the Texas Health and Safety Code (Controlled Substances Act).
7. On or about July 17, 2008, Respondent entered a plea of Guilty to the offense of OBTAIN DRUGS BY FRAUD- SCH II/IV (a 3rd Degree felony offense committed on February 24, 2008), in the 178th District Court of Harris County, Texas, under Cause No. 1158423. As a result of the guilty plea, the proceedings against Respondent were deferred without entering an adjudication of guilt, and she was placed on probation for a period of two (2) years. Additionally, she was ordered to pay a fine and court costs.
8. On or about May 26, 2010, Respondent entered a plea of Guilty to FRAUD DEL CS/ PRESCRIPTION SCH III/IV/V (a 3rd degree felony offense committed on January 14, 2010), in the 267th District Court of Goliad County, Goliad, Texas, under Cause No. 10-02-4542CR. As a result of the guilty plea, the proceedings against Respondent were deferred without entering an adjudication of guilt, and she was placed on probation for a period of five (5) years. Additionally, she was ordered to pay a fine and court costs.
9. Respondent, by her signature to this Order, expresses her desire to voluntarily surrender her license to practice nursing in the State of Texas.
10. The Board policy implementing Rule 213.29 in effect on the date of this Agreed Order provides discretion by the Executive Director for consideration of conditional reinstatement after proof of twelve (12) consecutive months of abstinence from alcohol and drugs followed by licensure limitations/stipulations and/or peer assistance program participation.
11. The Board finds that there exists serious risks to public health and safety as a result of impaired nursing care due to intemperate use of controlled substances or chemical dependency.

CONCLUSIONS OF LAW

1. Pursuant to Texas Occupations Code, Sections 301.451-301.555, the Board has jurisdiction over this matter.
2. Notice was served in accordance with law.
3. The evidence received is sufficient to prove violation of Section 301.452(b)(3)&(10), Texas Occupations Code, and 22 TEX. ADMIN. CODE §217.12(10)(B)(E),(11)(B)&(13).

4. The evidence received is sufficient cause pursuant to Section 301.453(a), Texas Occupations Code, to take disciplinary action against Registered License Number 689345, heretofore issued to RACHEL MARIE GOSLIN, including revocation of Respondent's license to practice nursing in the State of Texas.
5. Under Section 301.453(c), Texas Occupations Code, the Board has the authority to accept the voluntary surrender of a license.
6. Under Section 301.453(d), Texas Occupations Code, as amended, the Board may impose conditions for reinstatement of licensure.
7. Any subsequent reinstatement of this license will be controlled by Section 301.453(d), Texas Occupations Code, and 22 TEX. ADMIN. CODE §213.26-.29, and any amendments thereof in effect at the time of the reinstatement.

ORDER

NOW, THEREFORE, IT IS AGREED and ORDERED that the VOLUNTARY SURRENDER of Registered License Number 689345, heretofore issued to RACHEL MARIE GOSLIN, to practice nursing in the State of Texas, is accepted by the Texas Board of Nursing. In connection with this acceptance, the Board imposes the following conditions:

1. RESPONDENT SHALL NOT practice professional nursing, use the title "registered nurse" or the abbreviation "RN" or wear any insignia identifying herself as a registered nurse or use any designation which, directly or indirectly, would lead any person to believe that RESPONDENT is a registered nurse during the period in which the license is surrendered.
2. RESPONDENT SHALL NOT ~~petition for reinstatement of licensure until:~~ one (1) year has elapsed from the date of this Order; and, RESPONDENT has obtained objective, verifiable proof of twelve (12) consecutive months of sobriety immediately preceding the petition.
3. Upon petitioning for reinstatement, RESPONDENT SHALL satisfy all then existing requirements for relicensure.

IT IS FURTHER AGREED and ORDERED that this Order SHALL be applicable to Respondent's nurse licensure compact privileges, if any, to practice nursing in the State of Texas.


