APPLICANT for Initial Licensure § CONDITIONAL ELIGIBILITY

On the date entered below, the Texas Board of Nursing, hereinafter referred to as Board, considered the Application for Initial Licensure by Examination and supporting documents filed by JUNE REVA ROYER, hereinafter referred to as APPLICANT, together with any documents and information gathered by staff and APPLICANT's Certificate contained herein. Information received by the Board produced evidence that APPLICANT may have violated Section 301.452(b)(10), Texas Occupations Code.

APPLICANT waived representation by counsel, notice and hearing, and agreed to the entry of this Order offered on August 28, 2008, by Katherine A. Thomas, MN, RN, Executive Director.

FINDINGS OF FACT

1. On or about April 17, 2008, Applicant submitted an Application for Initial Licensure by Examination requesting a determination of eligibility for licensure in compliance with Sections 301.252 and 301.257 of the Texas Occupations Code and the Board's Rules at 22 Texas Administrative Code Sections 213.30 and 217.2.
2. Applicant waived representation, notice, administrative hearing, and judicial review.
3. At the time the petition was submitted, Applicant was enrolled in a Nursing Program at Lamar State College, Orange, Texas.
4. Applicant provided a "yes" answer to the question which reads in part as follows: *"Within the past five (5) years have you been addicted to and/or treated for the use of alcohol or any other drug?"*
5. Applicant submitted a letter dated April 24, 2008, stating she entered Home of Grace, a woman's Christian based recovery program, in order to stop using alcohol and marijuana.

Applicant graduated from the program and has been clean and sober since May 23, 2006. Applicant attends regular meetings at the Agape Freedom Group of Narcotics Anonymous, works with her sponsor on the 12-Step Program, and leads one meeting a week.

6. Applicant presented evidence of current fitness to practice vocational nursing, provided Applicant complies with the stipulations as outlined in this Order.
7. The safety of patients and the public requires that all persons licensed to practice nursing be fit, and able to consistently practice nursing in autonomous roles under demanding and stressful conditions.
8. The Executive Director considered evidence of Applicant's substance abuse and subsequent rehabilitation as provided in §213.29, 22 Texas Administrative Code.
9. The Executive Director's review of the grounds for potential ineligibility has been made on the basis of the information provided by Applicant.
10. Applicant has sworn that, with the exception of matters disclosed in connection with the Application for Initial Licensure, her past behavior conforms to the Board's professional character requirements. Applicant presented no evidence of behavior which is inconsistent with the Board's character requirements in 22 Texas Administrative Code §213.27.
11. On August 28, 2008, the Executive Director considered evidence of Applicant's past behavior in light of the character factors set out in 22 Texas Administrative Code §213.27 and determined that Applicant currently demonstrates the criteria required for good professional character.
12. In consideration of Applicant's past conduct and subsequent evidence of rehabilitation, the Executive Director finds that Applicant should be declared conditionally eligible to take the National Council Licensure Examination for Practical Nurses.
13. Applicant's compliance with the terms of a Board approved peer assistant program should be sufficient to protect patients and the public.

CONCLUSIONS OF LAW

1. The Texas Board of Nursing has jurisdiction over this matter pursuant to Section 301.453, Texas Occupations Code.
2. Applicant has submitted an Application for Initial Licensure by Examination requesting a determination of eligibility for licensure in compliance with Sections 301.252 and 301.257 of the Texas Occupations Code and the Board's Rules at 22 Texas Administrative Code Sections 213.30 and 217.2.
3. Applicant shall immediately notify the Board of any fact or event that could constitute a

ground of ineligibility for licensure under Section 301.452, Texas Occupations Code.

4. The Texas Board of Nursing may license an individual who has a history of substance abuse, after consideration of the criteria set out in 22 Texas Administrative Code §213.29, the Board determines that Applicant does not currently pose a direct threat to the health and safety of patients or the public.
5. The Board may, in its discretion, order a Applicant, upon initial licensure as a vocational nurse, to participate in a peer assistance program approved by the Board if the nurse would otherwise have been eligible for referral to peer assistance pursuant to Section 301.410, Texas Occupations Code.

ORDER

NOW, THEREFORE, IT IS ORDERED that upon meeting the requirements for graduation and payment of any required fees, JUNE REVA ROYER, APPLICANT, is CONDITIONALLY ELIGIBLE to sit for the National Council Licensure Examination for Practical Nurses (NCLEX-NCLEX-PN® Examination). APPLICANT SHALL NOT be eligible for temporary authorization to practice as a Graduate Nurse in the State of Texas.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that APPLICANT SHALL comply in all respects with the Nursing Practice Act, Texas Occupations Code §§301.001 *et seq.*, the Rules and Regulations Relating to Professional Nurse Education, Licensure and Practice, 22 TEX. ADMIN. CODE §211.1 *et seq.*, and this Order.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that APPLICANT, upon attaining a passing grade on the NCLEX-PN®, shall be issued a license to practice vocational nursing in the State of Texas.

IN ADDITION, IT IS THEREFORE FURTHER AGREED and ORDERED that APPLICANT, upon initial licensure, SHALL comply with the following conditions for such a time as is required for APPLICANT to successfully complete the Texas Peer Assistance Program for Nurses (TPAPN):

(1) APPLICANT SHALL, within forty-five (45) days of initial licensure, apply to and be accepted into the TPAPN, which SHALL include payment of a non-refundable participation

fee in the amount of THREE HUNDRED FIFTY DOLLARS (\$350.00) payable to TPAPN.

(2) Upon acceptance into the TPAPN, APPLICANT SHALL waive confidentiality and provide a copy of the executed TPAPN contract to the Texas Board of Nursing .

(3) APPLICANT SHALL comply with all requirements of the TPAPN contract during its term.

(4) APPLICANT SHALL CAUSE the TPAPN to notify the Texas Board of Nursing of any violation of the TPAPN contract.

IT IS FURTHER AGREED and ORDERED that this Order SHALL be applicable to Applicant's multistate licensure privileges, if any, to practice vocational nursing in the State of Texas.

IT IS FURTHER AGREED and ORDERED that while Applicant's license is encumbered by this Order, Applicant may not work outside the State of Texas pursuant to a multistate licensure privilege without the written permission of the State of Texas and the Board of Nursing in the party State where Applicant wishes to work.

IT IS FURTHER AGREED, SHOULD APPLICANT fail to comply with this Order or the terms of the participation agreement with the TPAPN, such noncompliance will result in further disciplinary action including revocation of APPLICANT's license to practice vocational nursing in the State of Texas.

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APPLICANT'S CERTIFICATION

I am the Applicant in this matter. I have fully and truthfully disclosed all relevant information in conformity with Rule 213.29 at Texas Administrative Code. I certify that my past behavior, except as disclosed in my Application for Initial Licensure by Examination, has been in conformity with the Board's professional character rule. I have no criminal prosecution pending in any jurisdiction.

In connection with my application, I acknowledge that I have read and I understand Section 301.257, Texas Occupations Code, Section 301.452 (a),(b) and (c), Texas Occupations Code, and Chapter 53, Section 53.001 *et seq.*, Texas Occupations Code, and Board Rules 213.27, 213.28, and 213.29 at 22 Texas Administrative Code. I agree with all terms of this Order, including the Findings of Fact and Conclusions of Law and any stipulations set out in this Order. I acknowledge that this Order is stipulated and I understand that I am not eligible to receive a Graduate Nurse Permit to practice. I agree to inform the Board of any other fact or event that could constitute a ground for denial of licensure prior to registering for the NCLEX-PN® Examination or accepting any permit or license from the Texas Board of Nursing .

I understand that if I fail to comply with all terms and conditions of this Order, I will be subject to investigation and disciplinary sanction, including revocation of my license to practice professional nursing in the State of Texas, as a consequence of my noncompliance.

I understand that I can be represented by an attorney in this matter. I waive representation, notice, administrative hearing, and judicial review of this Order and request that the Executive Director of the Texas Board of Nursing enter this Order.


