ORDER GRANTING PETITIONER'S REQUEST FOR EXCEPTION

On this day, the Executive Director, on behalf of the Texas Board of Nursing, hereinafter referred to as the "Board", considered Petitioner's Request for Exception filed in the above-styled matter. An Agreed Order of the Board was entered on February 11, 2014, for THOMAS DUNLEAVY SMITH, Registered Nurse License Number 742341. Petitioner filed a Request for Exception to the Agreed Order on May 22, 2015. After review and due consideration of the Petitioner's request, and pursuant to 22 Tex. Admin. Code §211.7(h), the Executive Director of the Board **GRANTS** Petitioner's Request for Exception. Therefore, Petitioner is required to comply with and complete all of the requirements of the February 11, 2014, Agreed Order, except that Stipulation Number Eight (8) is modified as follows:

(8) PETITIONER SHALL NOT administer or have any contact with controlled substances, Nubain, Stadol, Dalgan, Ultram, or other synthetic opiates for one (1) year of employment as a nurse, except while employed with Kindred Hospital, Arlington, Texas.

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However, should Petitioner's employment with Kindred Hospital, Arlington, Texas, cease or change for any reason, Stipulation Number eight (8) shall have its full force and effect.
