On this day came to be considered by the Board of Nurse Examiners for the State of Texas, hereinafter referred to as the Board, the matter of registered nurse license number 215172, held by DINAH A.R. PERKINS, hereinafter referred to as Respondent.

Information received by the Board produced evidence that Respondent may have violated Article 4525(b)(1), Revised Civil Statutes of Texas, as amended.

Respondent was notified of the investigation, waived counsel and hearing and consented to the entry of this Order, offered, subject to Board ratification, by Louise Waddill, PhD, RN, Executive Director.

FINDINGS OF FACT

1. Notice of the matters specified below in the Findings of Fact, number 7, was served on Respondent prior to the institution of agency proceedings.
2. Respondent was given the opportunity to show compliance with all requirements of the law for retention of the license.
3. Respondent waived representation by counsel, informal conference and administrative hearing.
4. Respondent stipulated to the Findings of Fact contained in this Order.
5. DINAH A.R. PERKINS, hereinafter referred to as Respondent, is licensed to practice professional nursing in the State of Texas.
6. Respondent's license to practice professional nursing in the State of Texas expired in January, 1994.

7. Respondent continued to practice professional nursing at Evergreen Presbyterian Ministries, Longview, Texas, without a current license until October 21, 1994.
8. Respondent renewed her license to practice nursing on or about October 21, 1994.
9. Respondent desires to continue her career in professional nursing.

CONCLUSIONS OF LAW

1. That pursuant to Article 4525, Revised Civil Statutes of Texas, as amended the Board has jurisdiction over this matter.
2. Notice was served in accordance with law.
3. That the evidence received was sufficient to prove a violations of Article 4525(b)(1) and 4526, TEX.REV.CIV.STAT.ANN.
4. That the activities of the Respondent constituted sufficient cause pursuant to Article 4525(b), TEX.REV.CIV.STAT.ANN, to take disciplinary action against license number 215172, heretofore issued to DINAH A.R. PERKINS.

AGREED TERMS, STIPULATIONS AND CONDITIONS

IT IS THEREFORE AGREED, subject to ratification by the Board of Nurse Examiners, that Respondent receive the discipline of warning.



1. DINAH A.R. PERKINS, hereinafter referred to as Respondent, is licensed to practice professional nursing in the State of Texas.
2. Respondent's license to practice professional nursing in the State of Texas expired in January of 1994.
3. Respondent continued to practice professional nursing at Evergreen Presbyterian Ministries, Longview, Texas, without a current license until October 21, 1994.
4. Respondent renewed her license to practice nursing on or about October 21, 1994.
5. Respondent desires to continue her career in professional nursing.

CONCLUSIONS OF LAW

1. That pursuant to Article 4525, Revised Civil Statutes of Texas, as amended the Board has jurisdiction over this matter.
2. That the evidence received was sufficient to prove a violations of Article 4525(b)(1) and 4526, TEX.REV.CIV.STAT.ANN.
3. That the activities of the Respondent constituted sufficient cause pursuant to Article 4525(b), TEX.REV.CIV.STAT.ANN, to take disciplinary action against license number 215172, heretofore issued to DINAH A.R. PERKINS.


